Request a Waiver for Rule: E

Env-712.23

Initial Monitoring for Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS)

This form should be used by water systems to request a waiver in accordance with Env-Dw 712.23(c) through Env-Dw 712.23(e). The requirement is to conduct four initial quarterly rounds of PFAS monitoring. If the sample results of the first 2 quarters are below the detection limits for all four regulated PFAS contaminants (PFOA, PFOS, PFNA, & PFHxS), the remaining initial monitoring shall be waived and the future PFAS monitoring frequency determined in accordance with Env-Dw 712.24. If NHDES determines that your water system is eligible, you will be notified that the water system's monitoring schedule for PFAS has been modified.

NOTE: If the two quarters were not taken consecutively, you must also submit the PFAS-Consecutive Quarter Sampling Waiver form located on the <u>DES OneStop site</u> where you currently find sampling forms.
