There is no NHDES requirement to notify the current property of the November 14, 2018 issuance of the renewed groundwater management permit for the subject site. As noted in the cover letter, a Notice of the initial permit was recorded in the chain of title for the property with the Cheshire County Registry of Deeds in September 2013. The NHDES assumes that when Turnkey Lumber, Inc. subsequently purchased the property, they would have completed a deed search that would have revealed the existence of the permit Notice thereby communicating the presence of petroleum contamination on the property.

When the permit renewal was drafted, I decided to include Mr. Fernandes at Turnkey Lumber in the distribution so that he would be aware of the continuing requirement for CR Bard, Inc. to complete groundwater monitoring activities at the site.
