Dear Ms. Simons:

NHDES has received your letter dated September 12, 2018 regarding Administrative Order No. 18-013 WMD (the "Order"). NHDES has reviewed the information enclosed in the letter and has the following comments:

- 1) NHDES does not accept Underground Storage Tank ("UST") certification training conducted in states outside of New Hampshire. A list of approved UST operator training classes can be found at <https://www.des.nh.gov/organization/divisions/waste/orcb/ocs/ustp/operator-training/training-classes.htm>. To achieve compliance with item E.3.a and b in the Order, an individual must attend an **approved** NHDES operator training and submit a complete Statement of Training (enclosed) identifying the class A and B operator that is signed by both the owner and designated operators.
- 2) The designated class A or B operator, or an individual under the direction of the class A or B operator must conduct monthly visual inspections at the subject site. To achieve compliance with item E.3.c in the Order, conduct monthly visual inspections by or under the direction of the class A or B operator, record the results of the inspection in a monthly inspection report, and submit a copy of the most recent inspection report to NHDES.
- 3) The UST owner is required to notify NHDES at least 14 days prior to any UST system permanent closure. To achieve compliance with item E.2 in the Order, complete the Underground/Aboveground Storage Tank Closure Notification Form (enclosed) and submit to NHDES at least 14 days before the scheduled permanent closure. Env-Or 408.06 through Env-Or 408.10 require that a certified tank remover must be present on-site during all closure activities; representative samples must be collected; and a closure report must be submitted to NHDES 30 days after the samples are collected.
