Mark,

I apologize to have missed you call yesterday; I was unexpectedly out of the office.

Are you the new contact for the facility or a new owner? I have included the email provided for the UST facility's contact to ensure Lloyd Helm receives this email. Please submit an updated registration if there have been changes to information on the registration (see attached). You may submit just submit Page 1 if you are updating just the owner or a contact.

I have discussed the compliance of the facility with Matt Jones and I am providing you with a summary based on our review:

- The Administrative Order requested the following:
  - o Permanent closure of tank #1 (diesel) -
    - Completed NHDES has received the closure report
  - Designation of a class A and B Operator by submittal of a Statement of Training form -
    - Completed NHDES received a Statement of training form designating Laura Simons as the class A and B operator
  - Action for Liquid in Dispenser Sump #1/2 -
    - Not Completed Please investigate the cause of the liquid in the sump, determine if a release has occurred and submit a written report to NHDES that describes the investigation and its conclusions in accordance with Env-Or 406.04(c).
  - Action for Monthly Visual Inspections not being conducted -
    - Please conduct monthly visual inspections in accordance with RSA 146-C and Env-Or 406.18 and provide a copy of recent monthly visual inspections to NHDES.
- An inspection was conducted on November 19, 2019 by NHDES and the following deficiencies remain from the inspection:
  - o Monthly visual inspections have not been consistently or comprehensively conducted -
    - <u>Please conduct monthly visual inspections in accordance with RSA 146-C and Env-Or 406.18 and provide a copy of recent monthly visual inspections to NHDES.</u>
  - o Temporary closure requirements not met -
    - Please place locks on the fill caps of all temporary closed tanks and remove product to > 1 inch per Env-Or 408.04(a)
  - Please note that additional deficiencies were noted in the inspection report that do not apply currently because the gasoline tanks are in temporary closure.

Based on the review of NHDES records, NHDES determined tanks #2 and #3 have been temporary closed since February 16, 2017.

Env-Or 408.04(e) requires any portion of a UST system with secondary containment and leak monitoring that has been temporarily closed for 3 years shall, within 30 days be reactivated per Env-Or 408.04(f), allowed to remain in temporary

closure provided the conditions specified in Env-Or 408.04(g) are met or permanently closed in accordance with Env-Or 408.06 through 408.10.

To correct this deficiency, submit documentation of implementation of whichever option you selected. Please reach out to NHDES should you have any questions on the documentation required. Please note the facility is past the deadline specified in Env-Or 408.04(e). Please respond with the intent for the facility in a timely manner.
