**Notice of Federal Lien Under the Comprehensive
Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act,
as amended ("CERCLA"), 42 U.S.C. §§9601 et seq.**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the United States that it holds a lien on the lands and premises described below situated in the State of New Hampshire, as provided by Section 107(l) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, as amended ("CERCLA"), 42 U.S.C. § 9607(1), to secure payment to the United States of all costs and damages for which Troy Mills Inc., is liable under Section 107(a) of CERCLA. This lien is authorized by the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of West Virginia (*In re: Troy Mills, Incorporated*; Bk. No.: 01-13341).

The lien for which this instrument gives notice exists in favor of the United States upon all real property and rights to such property which belong to such person and are, have been, or will be subject to, or affected by, the response actions, as defined by federal law, at the Troy Mills Superfund Site, in the Town of Troy, Cheshire County, New Hampshire. Such property includes, but is not limited to, the 32 acres of commercial/industrial property; 9 acres of gravel pit; 203 acres mixed use; and, 26 acres of wetland/rural property and further defined on the Town of Troy, New Hampshire Tax Map 17, Lot 0025.

This statutory lien exists and shall continue until the liability for costs and damages (or a judgment against such persons arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable through the operation of the statute of limitations as provided by Section 113 of CERCLA, 41 U.S.C. § 9613.

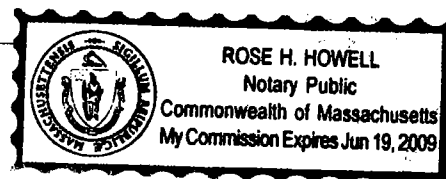
