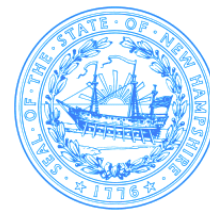

This letter provides authorization for GZA GeoEnvironmental, Inc. (GZA) to continue work on the Troy Mills Landfill Superfund Site per- and polyfluoroalkyl substance (PFAS) assessment tasks per their June 13, 2022 *Proposed Scope of Services and Budget Estimate – Supplemental PFAS Assessment*, previously approved in WSA#4 on August 11, 2022 under a prior contract, up to the balance of the outstanding budget, as follows:
