Enclosed please find a copy of the 2021 Annual Facility Report for Active Solid Waste Facilities for Tradebe Treatment and Recycling Northeast, L.L.C. located at 410 Shattuck Way, Newington, by Solid Waste Permit DES-SW-SP-18-002 and Env-Sw 1105.07. Approximately 16% of the solid waste managed at the Facility over the course of 2021 was from NH sources, thus providing a public benefit to the citizens of the state. In addition, the quantity of solid waste transferred by the facility to New Hampshire landfills and incinerators did not exceed the quantity of solid waste received by the facility from New Hampshire generators.
