**NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF PERMIT REVIEW PUBLIC HEARING AND  
COMMENT PERIOD**

On October 4, 2019, pursuant to the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules, Env-A 621.02, notice was given that the Director of the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Air Resources Division (Director), had received an application for a temporary permit from, and based on the information received to date, intended to **issue such permit to:**

**Saint-Gobain Performance Plastics Corporation  
701 Daniel Webster Highway  
Merrimack, New Hampshire**

**For the Following Devices:  
Coated Fabrics and Films Manufacturing Operations  
and Two Emergency Engines**

The temporary permit requires the use of a regenerative thermal oxidizer as Best Available Control Technology for control of emissions of perfluorinated compounds and precursors from the coated fabric and films manufacturing operations.

The October 4, 2019 public notice also stated that the Director had scheduled a public hearing for Tuesday, November 5, 2019 at the James Masticola Upper Elementary School in Merrimack, NH. At the November 5, 2019 public hearing, the Director announced that the public comment period would continue to remain open until 4:00 p.m. on Friday, December 6, 2019.

On December 5, 2019, the Director received a request to extend the public comment deadline from December 6, 2019 to Tuesday, December 31, 2019. In response, **the Director has extended the deadline to submit comments to 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 31, 2019.**

The application and draft permit are on file with the Director, New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Air Resources Division, 29 Hazen Drive, P.O. Box 95, Concord, NH 03302-0095, (603) 271-1370. Information may be reviewed at the office during working hours from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. The draft permit application review summary and draft permit can be accessed electronically through the One-Stop Data and Information portal at <http://www.des.nh.gov>. Written comments filed with the Director in accordance with Env-A 621.06, and received no later than **4:00 p.m. on December 31, 2019**, shall be considered by the Director in making a final decision.
