From Memorial Day to Labor Day the water at this beach is routinely tested for the presence of fecal bacteria

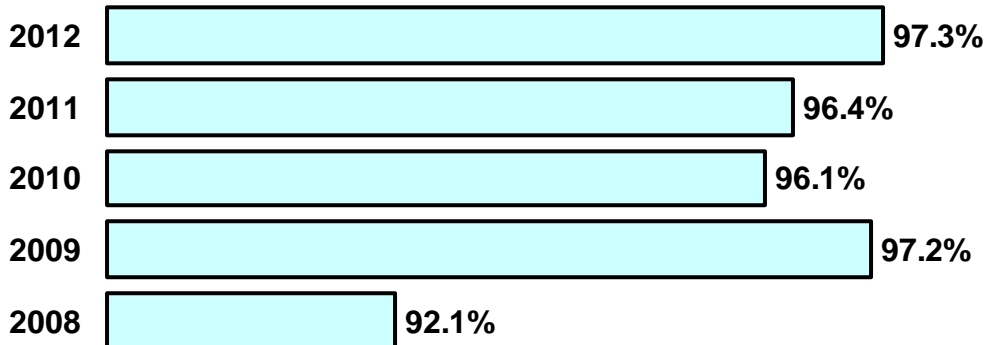

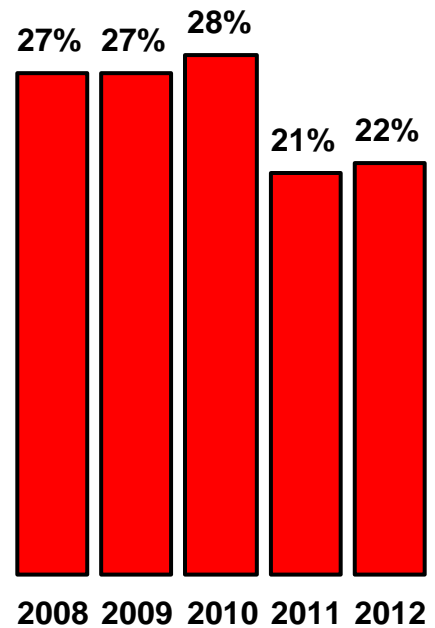

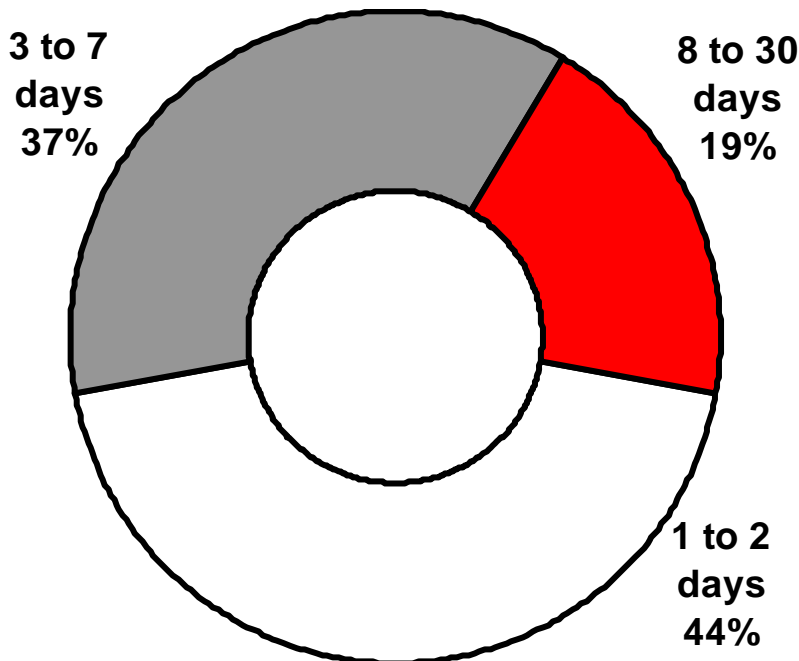
