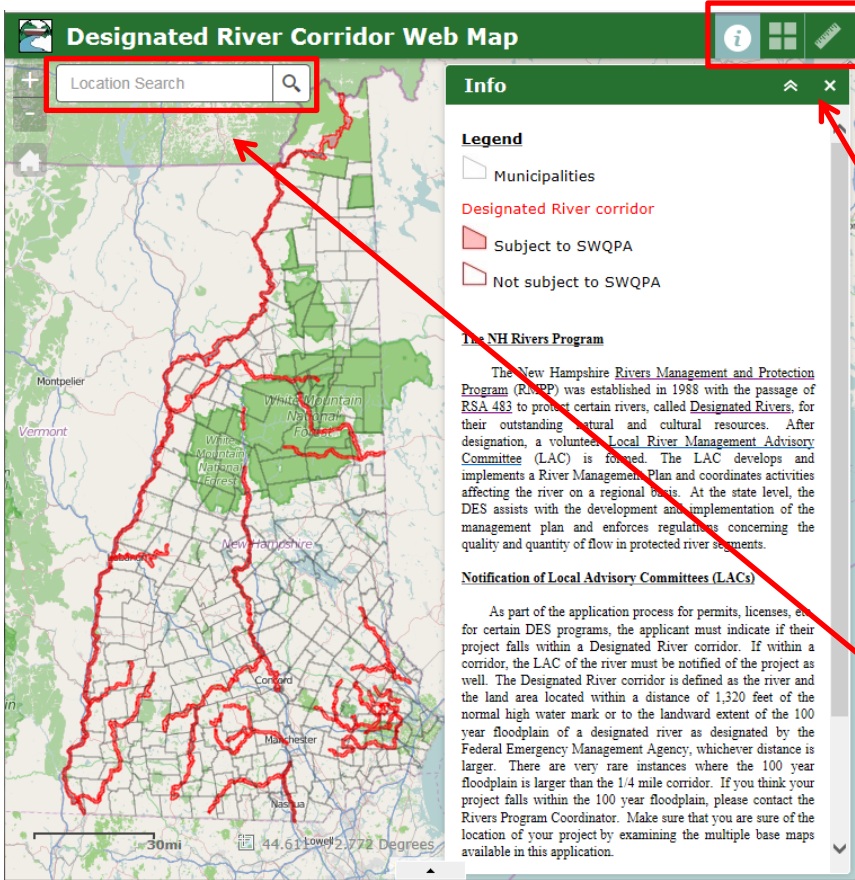


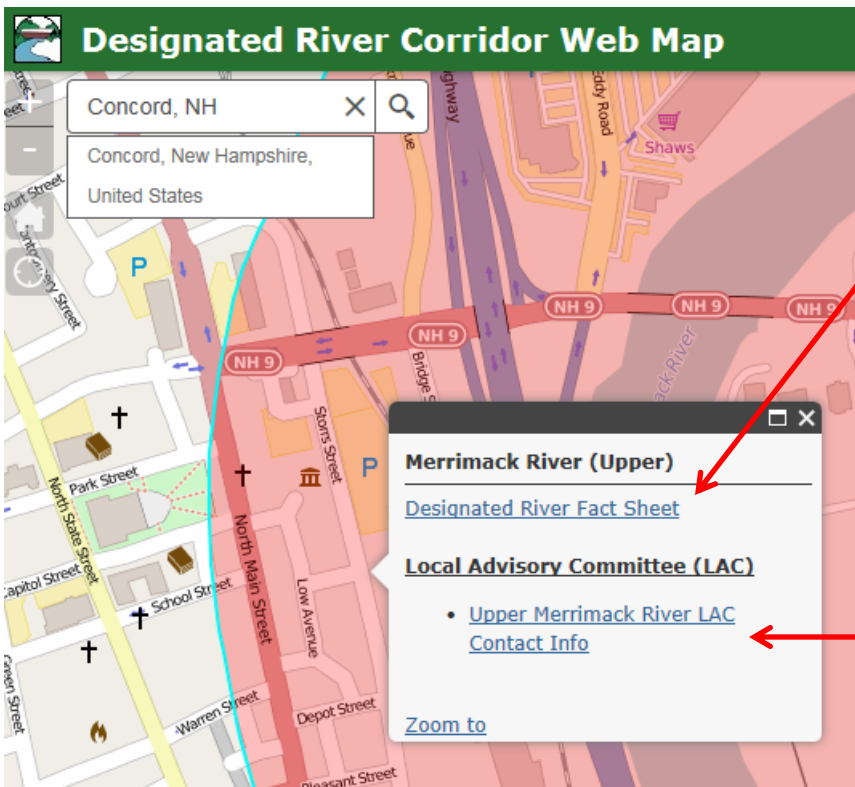
# Designated River Corridor Web Map Instructions

This map provided by the NH Rivers Management and Protection Program is designed to aid applicants for permits, licenses, and certifications in determining if they need to notify a Local Advisory Committee (LAC) of their proposed project. This is also a resource for the LACs to explore their jurisdiction, and review the permit notifications they receive from the state.



- Info:** This displays by default, it includes information and links for the Rivers Program, the permit notification process, and the Shoreland Water Quality Protection Act
- Other Background Maps:** This gallery includes 3 different street maps and aerial photos
- Measurement Tools:** These allow the user to measure distances, areas, and location coordinates

**Location Search:** This can search for many types of locations including address, coordinates, and place names. It also provides suggestions and edits related to search terms
