


Black River Action Team Bio Blitz

# Making it Manageable

#### LAC Social Media Communication Strategy / Plan

Goals: are higher reaching plans listed in your communication strategy and derived from your management plan that motivate the LAC to achieve more than the minimum duties listed in statute.


