- Turn right onto Rt-9/Rt-108/Central Ave. and follow Approx. 1-mile.
- Turn Right onto Lowell Avenue (across from Wentworth Douglass Hospital) and follow to the end at the Water Works Facility entrance.

Bring: Friends and family, water to drink and packed lunch, gardening/work gloves, sunscreen, bug spray, spade or shovel, buckets

Wear: work clothes and boots
